INT. A COMPUTER ROOM - DAY

BAZ HOPPS is typing at a computer. BAZ HARROLD walks in from a door on the opposite side of the room and walks over, he speaks.

HARROLD

Hopps?

HOPPS

What?

HARROLD

You remember that Richard who came by?

HOPPS

Yeah, what about him?

HARROLD

I've just debugged the authorisation software and it looks like they never asked him for any identification.

HOPPS

You know what they're like. Nora Taylor and Kathryn Foster a tribute to incompetence.

HARROLD

This is rather serious, Hopps. We don't know who he is, and we just volunteered information!

HOPPS

It wasn't anything important. Not like we gave him much anyways.

HARROLD

How can we judge what is and is not important information?

HOPPS

You're right, but what are we going to do about it? He's gone.

HARROLD

Not necessarily. We can't just go to Nora with nothing. But we can try and find the transport he came in on. Where there's a Richard, a ship isn't far behind.

INT. THE SHIP - DAY

RICHARD HARD and DIANA STRANGE are in the ship, picking up from their final scene in the previous episode.

RICHARD HART

What do you mean she's the reason it's abandoned?

DIANA STRANGE Ah- it's a long story.

RICHARD HART Give me the short version.

DIANA STRANGE

She got them flagged up for an inspection, and it got everyone working there killed. Then they shut it down, full stop.

RICHARD HART What did they do to warrant that?

DIANA STRANGE

I don't know all the details, all I know is that they were smuggling something out for her. That's about it.

RICHARD HART

She never told you?

DIANA STRANGE

No, never. She never told us where it was.

RICHARD HART

How do you know this is it then?

DIANA STRANGE

The dates of it's closing match up to something else I remember from that time. I'm confident this is the place.

RICHARD HART

That may be but it doesn't inspire much confidence on my part.

DIANA STRANGE

What are you talking about? This has to be the place.

I still think it's worth approaching some of the locals, even if she was interested in the outpost, we have no proof she went there.

DIANA STRANGE

We have no proof she came here! Why would she come all the way to this system, to not visit the outpost that she had strong and legitimate connections with.

RICHARD HART

But I don't know that this is even that place. There must be dozens of closed outposts in the galaxy, why is this the one.

DIANA STRANGE

The dates-

RICHARD HART

Mean nothing, they could have been part of a mass shut down of outposts. It could have happened simultaneously with the real one.

DIANA STRANGE

It must means that this place is still worth investigating, logically. It's the strongest lead we have.

RICHARD HART

I have a lead as well that I think could be more substantial.

DIANA STRANGE

Oh yeah?

RICHARD HART

Yes, some locals described a young boy who kept speaking about a Nora.

DIANA STRANGE

That could be a Nora stationed here! Who says that's Evers?

RICHARD HART

It's stronger than this outpost.

DIANA STRANGE

You're delusional! If you're too proud to see that this is the best possible lead we have then you're a bigger fool than I thought.

I-

DIANA STRANGE

No, no please. Defend yourself. Tell me how I'm a moron and how I'm taking over your investigation. I know this is it, and either you trust me on this or you don't. So forget whether or not you like me, think about whether or not you trust me. Whether or not you trust my instincts.

RICHARD HART

I- you... ugh... fine.

DIANA STRANGE

Thank you. Fire up the engines, we're going now.

Diana walks away, Richard grumbles to himself.

INT. COMPUTER ROOM - DAY

Baz Hopps walks over to Baz Harrold who is on a workstation.

HOPPS

Right, I've got the identifier here.

HARROLD

I'll see if I can locate it.

Harrold starts typing on a keyboard.

HOPPS

This doesn't look right.

HARROLD

What doesn't?

HOPPS

The identifier, something's wrong with it, I just don't know what.

HARROLD

Right, I've got something here... yes... there it is... it's flying.

HOPPS

The code doesn't fit the same patterns as other ships I've seen... it looks... Scrambled, it's scrambled! He's got a boosted signal generator.

HARROLD

I've got him, we need to tell Nora. He's headed to... he's flying towards the old outpost.

FADE TO:

EXT. OUTSIDE FACILITY - DAY

The door to the ship opens and Diana and Richard step out.

DIANA STRANGE

I don't think your access code is going to work on that door.

RICHARD HART

No. It won't.

DIANA STRANGE

I could try rewiring the console.

RICHARD HART

That could take hours.

DIANA STRANGE

Do you have an alternative?

RICHARD HART

How reinforced do you think that door is?

DIANA STRANGE

Probably a couple inches of... I'm guessing steel?

RICHARD HART

Right...

Richard walks away and back up into the ship.

DIANA STRANGE

Richard?... What are you doing?

Mechanisms start loading up in the ship.

DIANA STRANGE (CONT'D)

Richard what do you think you're doing?

A weapon starts to load up.

DIANA STRANGE (CONT'D)

No! Richard no! Stop!

Diana runs and takes cover.

A massive burst of energy is fired from the ship, it smashes down the door. Diana screams. In the aftermath Diana is breathing very heavily cowering against the ground. She looks up and around, Richard walks up to her.

RICHARD HART

Come on get up.

DIANA STRANGE

You're a fucking maniac.

RICHARD HART

The door's down, isn't it.

DIANA STRANGE

Do you know the chances of shrapnel hitting me? Or the ship!

RICHARD HART

It didn't, did it? Bit of a moot point.

Diana is breathing heavily, tries to speak and just starts laughing.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

And you say I'm the maniac.

FADE TO:

INT. THE OUTPOST - DAY

DIANA STRANGE and RICHARD HART are walking through the hallways of the outposts.

DIANA STRANGE

What do you make of it?

RICHARD HART

Someone's been here recently.

DIANA STRANGE

How can you tell?

RICHARD HART

Look at this console over here. It should be covered in dust. It's clean. Or at least cleaner.

DIANA STRANGE

We need to keep on guard.

RICHARD HART

Agreed.

DIANA STRANGE

Weapons out, keep the safety on.

They both draw weapons and keep walking.

FADE TO:

INT. A COLD ROOM - DAY

A door opens, RICHARD and DIANA walk through it.

RICHARD HART

Looks like the central processing room.

DIANA STRANGE

I hear a machine running, there must still be some functionality.

Diana walks over to a computer and starts working with it.

RICHARD HART

This place is a mess. Something bad happened here.

DIANA STRANGE

What?

RICHARD HART

Look at the burn marks on the wall, those are from blasters.

Richard keeps walking, he moves things out of the way.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

This is blood here.

DIANA STRANGE

I've got something. This looks like... yeah someone's been trying to reconstruct an encrypted transmission. Look like a William, yeah. William Crowley, we need to check the records and see if he's stationed anywhere else.

Diana hits a couple of keys and a recording starts playing.

WILLIAM CROWLEY

No, we haven't yet.

(a pause)

We're working as quickly as we can.

RICHARD HART

(over the top of the next line)

Do we have the other side of the conversation.

Diana taps a couple of buttons.

DIANA STRANGE

No, looks like a one way recording.

WILLIAM CROWLEY

I can't guarantee it will get there before then.

(a pause)

No, I know, but the tests that we're doing are incredibly volatile.

(a pause)

I'll have you know that I am incredibly well versed in clone biology.

(a pause)

We're working as hard as we can, but the next shipment we could hide it on wouldn't be until next month.

(a pause)

RG-48 is not an easy thing to fight, Nora!

DIANA STRANGE

Come on, that's got to be her.

RICHARD HART

Hang on.

WILLIAM CROWLEY

Theoretically it's possible, but the therapy would be intensive. It could unravel our DNA. It's a-

The recording fizzles out.

DIANA STRANGE

That's where the reconstruction cuts out... So... They were making something and smuggling it out...

RICHARD HART

It certainly seems that way. Do we know what RG-48 is?

DIANA STRANGE

No, I don't.

There is a scuttle behind them. They both turn, raising their weapons.

DIANA STRANGE (CONT'D)

You heard that?

RICHARD HART

Yup. Someone's in here.

DIANA STRANGE

If there is someone out there, make yourself known now or we will fire.

There is silence.

RICHARD HART

We don't mean you any harm... we're friends of Evers.

DIANA STRANGE

Hart!

RICHARD HART

Sh! We'll put our weapons down, we don't want to hurt you.

Richard powers down his weapon and puts it away.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

See, we're peaceful.

DIANA STRANGE

What are you doing?

RICHARD HART

It's fine. He's been following us since we were back at the entrance. He had every chance to jump us if he wanted. Isn't that right?

(a pause)

Put your weapon down Diana.

DIANA STRANGE

Not gonna happen!

RICHARD HART

Diana, now is your turn to trust me. Do it.

Diana is unsure but finally puts away her weapon.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

Thank you. You can come out now. We're not going to hurt you.

Some small footsteps shuffle out from behind the corner.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

There we go. It's okay, see? No quns.

DIANA STRANGE

Who are you? What's your name?

AXEL

My name's Axel.

Axel, lovely to meet you. I'm Richard, and this is Diana. Do you know our friend Nora Evers?

AXEL

Yeah.

RICHARD HART

You wouldn't happen to know where she is would you?

AXEL

No.

DIANA STRANGE

When was the last time you saw her?

AXEL

She left. While ago.

DIANA STRANGE

Did she say where she was going?

AXEL

No.

RICHARD HART

Are you alright, you look pale. Have you had anything to eat?

AXEL

I don't have any food left.

Axel sniffs and rubs his nose.

DIANA STRANGE

Do you live here, Axel?

AXEL

Sometimes.

DIANA STRANGE

Where are your parents?

AXEL

I don't know.

RICHARD HART

Will you come back to our ship, Axel? We could get you some food?

AXEL

Okay.

FADE TO:

INT. THE SHIP - DAY

RICHARD walks over to DIANA.

RICHARD HART

He says Evers found him about two months ago he helped her, he didn't elaborate much on that.

DIANA STRANGE

You were right about the boy being a lead. How old did he say he was?

RICHARD HART

Fifteen. That's nothing for a natural-born.

DIANA STRANGE

No, I know. What's he doing now?

RICHARD HART

He's just eating. I asked him to think of anything he could tell us about Evers. We'll see what he can comes up with.

DIANA STRANGE

Yeah.

INT. BREAKOUT ROOM - DAY

NORA TAYLOR, BAZ HOPPS and BAZ HARROLD are all stood in the breakout room.

HARROLD

I'm telling you Taylor, this is something we cannot ignore.

NORA TAYLOR

You're exaggerating, Harrold.

HOPPS

I don't think he is this time,
Nora. Think about how this sounds,
an anonymous Richard turns up
claiming to be on secret business,
we don't mention anything to
command, yet we give him
information and don't take
identification. How does that
sound?

HARROLD

I sounds to me as though we're all about to be terminated for Treason.

*

NORA TAYLOR

Fine! Alright!

HARROLD

You'd better do something right away.

NORA TAYLOR

Fine. I'll talk to command. But you need to do it with me.

HARROLD

Pardon?

HOPPS

Ugh... we could explain this better than her. She's right.

HARROLD

You know how I hate speaking with command. That's not my job.

HOPPS

It is now.

HARROLD

Oh fine.

Nora goes over to the console presses a series of buttons, opening a signal.

NORA TAYLOR

I hate talking to her.

The signal rings.

HARROLD

Just behave yourself.

Nora Vass answers the signal.

NORA VASS

Caracass Outpost, this is High-Admiral Vass.

NORA TAYLOR

High-Admiral Vass, this is Commander Nora Taylor.

NORA VASS

And what do you want Commander?

NORA TAYLOR

It's only that- ah... well you see we...

*

HOPPS

High-Admiral, Lieutenant Baz Hopps here, we think we may have had a small... little... security breach.

NORA VASS

Commander, I suggest you keep your inferiors under control.

NORA TAYLOR

Of course. Baz.

HOPPS

Apologies.

NORA TAYLOR

High-Admiral, we believe there may have been a security breach on Caracass.

NORA VASS

Explain.

NORA TAYLOR

We were visited by a Richard unit who was searching for a Nora unit.

NORA VASS

What identification was he carrying?

NORA TAYLOR

Ah- we're not certain.

NORA VASS

Pardon me?

NORA TAYLOR

We did not ask for any identification.

NORA VASS

(sighs)

Why does this not surprise me? Nora Taylor you have yet again proved your absolute ineptitude in any sort of command function.

NORA TAYLOR

But it's- we've- we have been able to track him! We located his ship and ah- well I'll allow Private Baz Harrold to explain this to you.

HARROLD

Why you-... Greetings Admiral.

NORA VASS

High Admiral.

HARROLD

Of course, High Admiral. Greetings.

NORA VASS

Well?

HARROLD

Ah- yes... well it would appear that he is currently using a stolen signal generator and has scrambled the code.

NORA VASS

So you allowed a potential Alliance agent on your system to just go about their business? Is that what you are telling me?

HARROLD

I- I believe that may be the case. When we presented him with information Baz Harrold and Baz Hopps and I were unaware of the lack of security performed on the-

NORA VASS

I'm sorry, did you say you provided him with information!?

HARROLD

Yes, Ma'am. At Commander Taylor's request.

NORA VASS

(sighs) And where is he going?

HARROLD

Pardon.

NORA VASS

You said you tracked him!

HARROLD

Ah- well- I- I believe Officer Hopps could explain that.

HOPPS

Ah- yes well... you see we tracked his signal generator... It appears to have landed outside of the abandoned outpost on the far side of the planet.

There is a very long pause.

HOPPS (CONT'D)

High-Admiral? Are you still there?

NORA VASS

You three have committed offences that could well be considered treasonous. I do not need to explain what happens to those suspected of treason.

HOPPS

No Ma'am.

NORA VASS

I fear you do not understand the severity of the situation you have found yourself in. You must travel to the outpost immediately and contain him. I am sending reinforcements. You will not fail. Is that understood?

NORA TAYLOR

Absolutely. We will proceed there now.

NORA VASS

Good.

The signal terminates.

FADE TO:

INT. THE SHIP - DAY

AXEL is eating and typing at a computer. There is a knock on the door and it opens.

DIANA STRANGE

Axel, are you alright?

AXEL

Yes, I am. Can I have some more food, please?

DIANA STRANGE

You might want to slow down.

AXEL

But I'm still hungry.

DIANA STRANGE

I know, just don't hurt your stomach.

Axel continues typing.

DIANA STRANGE (CONT'D)

What are you doing?

AXEL

I've connected to the server I made for Nora.

DIANA STRANGE

Hang on, what?

AXEL

She needed somewhere to keep all of her research.

DIANA STRANGE

Research for what?

AXEL

I don't know, she didn't tell me?

DIANA STRANGE

Can I see?

AXEL

Sure.

Diana goes to the terminal and starts to type.

DIANA STRANGE

How much is on here?

AXEL

She had about five terabytes. We were thinking about expanding it to be able to hold twenty.

DIANA STRANGE

You know a lot about technology, don't you?

AXEL

Yeah.

DIANA STRANGE

Who taught you that?

AXEL

No one, I taught myself.

DIANA STRANGE

Look at you.

Axel laughs and smiles.

DIANA STRANGE (CONT'D)

Do you think you could transfer this to the ship's systems?

AXEL

I think so, yeah.

DIANA STRANGE

Amazing, thank you.

There is another knock at the door and Richard comes in.

RICHARD HART

Can I talk to you?

DIANA STRANGE

Yeah. Are you alright to start,

Axel?

AXEL

Mhm.

DIANA STRANGE

Thank you.

INT. HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS

Diana walks into the hallway and the close the door.

DIANA STRANGE

He's got five terabytes of data from some server he set up with

her.

RICHARD HART

Seriously? Can we-

DIANA STRANGE

He's already transferring it to the ship's systems.

RICHARD HART

Fantastic!

DIANA STRANGE

What did you want?

Richard suddenly shifts to being very serious.

RICHARD HART

We may have a problem.

DIANA STRANGE

Show me?

Diana and Richard walk through to the bridge.

I've been tracking a ship that launched from the settlement we were in. It looks like it's from the Collective base.

DIANA STRANGE

Where's it headed?

RICHARD HART

It's coming here.

DIANA STRANGE

What?

RICHARD HART

They might have sussed us out. I've just read them scanning our signal generator.

DIANA STRANGE

Shit... That transfer is going to take time.

RICHARD HART

Time I don't know we have.

DIANA STRANGE

How long?

RICHARD HART

Ten minutes.

DIANA STRANGE

We need that data, Hart.

RICHARD HART

I know. I can try and stall them.

DIANA STRANGE

Do whatever you need to do.

FADE TO:

EXT. OUTSIDE THE OUTPOST, BY THE SHIP - DAY

A ship is landing. Diana is speaking over a communicator.

RICHARD HART

How long do we have?

DIANA STRANGE

The transfer is still on 80%. We need another eight minutes.

RICHARD HART

I don't know if we have that, Di.

DIANA STRANGE

Don't call me Di.

RICHARD HART

Just be ready to go on my mark.

DIANA STRANGE

Alright.

The ship has finished landing. NORA TAYLOR and BAZ HOPPS step out. They both draw their weapons.

NORA TAYLOR

Don't move!

HOPPS

Hands in the air!

RICHARD HART

Ah yes, we met earlier didn't we.

NORA TAYLOR

He said hands in the air!

RICHARD HART

Nora, listen to me, you really don't want to do this.

NORA TAYLOR

And why's that?

RICHARD HART

Because I promise you that as soon as you take me in, some very powerful people are going to be very cross with you.

NORA TAYLOR

I've already contacted command, they've given us the order to take you in.

RICHARD HART

I'm above Command.

HOPPS

Are you trying to tell us that you're above Nora Vass.

RICHARD HART

Nora Vass is hardly a blip on my radar. My orders come directly from the Council of Ministers.

HOPPS

Prove it.

NORA TAYLOR

Yeah! Let's see some ID.

RICHARD HART

I'm afraid that's classified.

HOPPS

If you won't come willingly we will take you.

RICHARD HART

It's quite funny seeing a Baz holding a weapon. I suppose you have to improvise when there's so few of you out here.

NORA TAYLOR

Are you threatening him.

RICHARD HART

Not at all, merely observing.

NORA TAYLOR

Right that's it, you're coming with us.

RICHARD HART

One moment.

Richard presses a button on his communicator.

NORA TAYLOR

What are you doing? Stop!

RICHARD HART

Diana?

HOPPS

Who are you talking to?

RICHARD HART

My colleague.

DIANA STRANGE

(over communicator)

Uh... yeah?

RICHARD HART

How long have we got?

NORA TAYLOR

Until what?

DIANA STRANGE

(over communicator)

Six minutes. Are you nearly done?

HOPPS

Six minutes until what?

RICHARD HART

Oh, I suppose I'll wrap it up then.

NORA TAYLOR

What are you talk-

Richard drops to the ground, rolls, pulls out his blaster and shoots Hoops and Taylor. They can be heard moaning. The gun releases pressure, it is out of ammunition.

RICHARD HART

Lucky that, I'm out. Right, they should be out for a bit. I'm coming back to the ship. Fire up the engines.

DIANA STRANGE

(Over communicator)

Got it.

Baz Harrold comes running up from within the ship.

HARROLD

Hopps! What have you done?!

Richard raises his gun.

RICHARD HART

Hold it right there.

HARROLD

You have nothing left to fire.

Baz Harrold draws a gun.

HARROLD (CONT'D)

You are going to come with us.

Richard sighs.

RICHARD HART

Alright, I give in.

Richard drops to the ground.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

Come and get me.

Baz Harrold presses a button and starts speaking into a communicator. Baz walks over to Richard while speaking.

BAZ HARROLD

Come in Caracass base. I've apprehended the suspect, send a communication to the reinforcements to come direct to the combat site.

KATHRYN FOSTER

(over communicator)

Confirmed.

BAZ HARROLD

Now, you need to-

Richard wrestles the gun from Baz Harrold, pushes him to the ground and punches him in the face, knocking him out. He gets up and starts to run. Pushing a button on the communicator as he goes.

RICHARD HART

We need to go, there's reinforcements on their way.

Richard runs up into the ship as the engines are starting up.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

We need to go now.

DIANA STRANGE

We still have another four!

RICHARD HART

We need to break this link now, they have reinforcements on the way.

DIANA STRANGE

We can't, we'll lose some of the data we already have, it's only four minutes.

RICHARD HART

In two minutes we could have twenty agents around us. What does your tactical brain say?

DIANA STRANGE

I- Ugh! Fine!

RICHARD HART

Go, get the kid to break the link. Try and salvage what we can, but I'm getting us out of here.

Diana runs off. Richard moves to the console, pressing buttons, the engines start to flare. He presses some more buttons, pulls off an intercom microphone off the hook and speaks into it.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

Brace for take off in three...

two... One...

The ship takes off. Richard speaks into the microphone again.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

I need someone in here, now.

Diana comes running in from the back of the ship.

DIANA STRANGE

What?

RICHARD HART

I need you on ops. I need to see what's coming, up. This is not going to be a clean jump, I'll tell you right now.

Diana starts typing on the console.

DIANA STRANGE

I'm picking something up just out of the atmosphere.

RICHARD HART

What?

DIANA STRANGE

Looks like volatile warp signatures.

RICHARD HART

They're here.

DIANA STRANGE

How long until we break the atmosphere?

RICHARD HART

Just about...

The shuttle gives a massive jolt.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

Now. Where are they... we should see it.

DIANA STRANGE

There!

RICHARD HART

No...

DIANA STRANGE

They've sent fucking a warship... Richard... we can't...

*

No, we can do this... we can do this...

There is an alert.

DIANA STRANGE

We've got an incoming from the warship.

RICHARD HART

Put it through.

Diana presses some buttons and the signal opens.

WILLIAM BARLEY

Unidentified Vessel, this is Captain William Barley of the SS Victorious. Power down your warp drive and prepare to be boarded. Failure to comply will result in your destruction. Fighters are being deployed now to meet you.

RICHARD HART

Close it.

Diana presses a button. The signal closes.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

What do we do?

DIANA STRANGE

What do you mean what do we do, we're had, this is it!

RICHARD HART

Come on, think of this as a simulation.

Axel runs into the bridge.

AXEL

What's going on?

RICHARD HART

It's okay, everything's going to be alright. Come on Diana, what do we do? I need your help, I can't think like you.

DIANA STRANGE

I- this... They've got fighters, and a warship, this is... I...

What would we need. There's got to be something that would give us enough time to make the jump.

DIANA STRANGE

We'd need something to disable them, something to stop their ships functioning. Something like an EM burst, one that our ship was shielded from, but we don't have anything like that.

AXEL

I could make one!

RICHARD HART

Yes! How long will that take?

AXEL

Umm... I could reconfigure some of the components from your signal generator and run it through the main power converters. If we output that signal through the shield buffer, it would work! But it will only work once, we won't have the parts for another burst.

RICHARD HART

How long, Axel?

AXEL

Five minutes.

RICHARD HART

Okay, go!

AXEL

Okay!

Axel runs off.

DIANA STRANGE

That's not enough, they will fire before that's ready.

RICHARD HART

We're just going to need a bloody good pilot.

DIANA STRANGE

No one's that good.

RICHARD HART

I'm gonna have to try.

*

*

DIANA STRANGE

No, Richard.

RICHARD HART

Do you want us to be captured? Do you want him to be captured? You know what they'll do to a little natural born orphan? It won't be good.

DIANA STRANGE

I'll get on the turret. We can do this.

RICHARD HART

Yes we can.

Diana moves to the gunner position and primes the weapons.

DIANA STRANGE

The fighters are coming in on either side.

The alert comes through again. Some buttons are pressed and it is again played.

WILLIAM BARLEY

Attention unidentified vessel. If you do not comply in thirty seconds, we will open fire.

Some buttons are pressed and the signal is shut off.

RICHARD HART

Axel, how's that EMP coming?

AXEL

It's coming!

RICHARD HART

Good! Hold on, this is about to get rough.

(to Diana)

You sure you want to do this?

DIANA STRANGE

I'm sure.

RICHARD HART

On my mark, fire on the closest ship... Three... Two... One.

Diana fires, screaming as she does.

Everything in the ship turns upside down. The engines are screeching. Weapons can be heard going off around them.

DIANA STRANGE

Come on!

More shots, an explosion.

DIANA STRANGE (CONT'D)

Got him!

RICHARD HART

Good, now don't get cocky.

Richard groans as he executes another massive manoeuvre.

There is an explosion as the ship is hit.

RICHARD HART (CONT'D)

We're hit!
